

Advent Prize Draws 2025

Terms & Conditions

Dated 06 October 2025

1. The prize draws are open to all UK residents aged 18 years or over except
 - 1.1 members of College Chambers ("the Promoter"),
 - 1.2 employees of College Chambers,
 - 1.3 members of College Chambers, employees, families, agents, or
 - 1.4 any third party directly associated with the administration of the prize draw.
2. The prize draw is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary. You will be automatically entered into the 24 prize draws once you have completed the form. The total number of entries will be limited to 1000. Any entries received after the limit is reached will not be entered into any of the prize draws.

All entries must be submitted via the MS Form (by an individual and not generated by computer) as seen on LinkedIn or in the Promoter's email footer. Entries are limited to one entry per person. For clarity, each entry will be entered into all 24 prize draws.

The opening date for entries is 00:01 on 27 October 2025. The closing date of the prize draw is 23:59 on 21 November 2025. Entries received after this time will not be accepted.

3. The competition is open only to residents of the UK. By entering the prize draws, you confirm that you are eligible to enter.
4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries that are not successfully completed due to technical faults, technical malfunctions, computer hardware or software failures, satellite, network, or server failures of any kind.

Winners will be chosen by random draw performed by a computer process (random number generator) on 22 November 2025 ("Draw Date") after entries close. There will be a minimum of three winners for each day from and including 01 December 2025 to, and including, 24 December 2025.

5. The winners will receive a pair of socks.

The winners will be notified by email (using details provided in their entry form) and will be tagged on LinkedIn on the relevant day. If a winner does not provide their postal address with their entry, the winner's prize will be forfeited, and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.

The prize will be sent to the winner by post within 7 days of being notified of their win. If you do not receive your prize either in good time or at all, the Promoter, its agents, or distributors will not, in any circumstances, be responsible or liable to compensate the winner, nor do they accept any liability for any loss or damage arising from the late or non-delivery of the prize.

6. The prize for a winner is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
7. The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.
8. The decision of the Promoter regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
9. The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. 11. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents, or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury, or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents, or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
